

Limited Lifetime Warranty for Rechargeable Electric Battery

What is Covered by the Warranty:

This warranty covers the Rechargeable Electric Battery ("Product"), which by its own nature is a consumable product, against defects in materials and workmanship under normal use and service for the lifetime of the Product, subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

What is Not Covered:

This warranty does not cover:

- The use of the Product beyond its lifetime period (defined ahead)
- Normal wear and tear
- Damage to the electric cables exposed to the environment
- Damage caused by misuse, abuse, or neglect
- Damage caused by a prolonged immersion in water
- Damage caused by accidents, collisions, or other external forces
- Damage caused by exposure to external fire, extreme temperatures, corrosive chemicals, or other non-natural harsh environments
- Damage caused by unauthorized repairs or modifications
- Damage caused by the use of incompatible parts or accessories
- Damage caused by use in sport competitions, races, or competitive contests

This warranty is transferable to subsequent owners of the Product, provided that the new owner registers the Product with the manufacturer within 30 days of its purchase. To register the Product, the new owner must visit the manufacturer's website at [manufacturer's website] and complete the warranty registration form.

How to Obtain Warranty Service:

To obtain warranty service, the purchaser shall contact the manufacturer directly at [manufacturer's contact information], providing his/her name, address, phone number, and a description of the problem. The manufacturer will then provide the Purchaser with instructions on how to return the Product for service.

Warranty Remedy:

If the Product is found to be defective under this warranty, the manufacturer will repair or replace it at its discretion. The purchaser will pay the shipping costs cost to return the product to the manufacturer, while the manufacturer will pay for the shipping costs associated with returning the Product received for service and delivering the repaired or replaced Product back to the Purchaser.

Limitations on Warranty:

This warranty is the only warranty that applies to the Product, and it supersedes all other warranties, express or implied. The manufacturer disclaims any liability for incidental or consequential damages arising out of the sale or use of the Product.

Disclaimer of Implied Warranties:

THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ARE DISCLAIMED TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

Consequential Damages:

IN NO EVENT SHALL THE MANUFACTURER BE LIABLE FOR ANY CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF THE SALE OR USE OF THE PRODUCT, EVEN IF THE MANUFACTURER HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, LOST PROFITS, LOST REVENUE, INCREASED COSTS, AND DAMAGE TO OTHER PROPERTY.

Governing Law:

This warranty is governed by the laws of the Republic of Indonesia.

Exclusive Remedy:

The remedies provided in this warranty are the exclusive remedies available to the Purchaser for any defect in the Product.

Entire Agreement:

This warranty constitutes the entire agreement between you and the manufacturer with respect to the Product and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous communications, representations, or agreements, whether oral or written.

Definitions and Additional Information:

- The Product is a consumable product by its nature; hence it is subject to a degradation of its performance during its lifetime, which is normal and expected.
- Definition of lifetime: The term "lifetime" is the actual lifetime period of the product, regardless of who owns it, as long as the current purchaser register it to the manufacturer, whether it is the first original purchase, or a subsequent purchase following a transfer or ownership (Second Hand purchase).
- Definition of Lifetime Period: The lifetime period is defined as:
 - a) the period between 100% performance and 80% performance, delivered by the Product;

or

- b) the number of charging cycles that the product has undergone, as defined in the Product specifications, defined by the Manufacturer;

whichever comes first.

- Definition of Normal Use and Service: Normal use and service means using the Product in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and for the purpose for which it was designed.
- List of Covered Items: This warranty covers the motor, the electronic controller, the internal cables and connectors, the propeller, and all other components of the Product.
- This warranty agreement does not cover the batteries, since they are considered consumable items with a lifetime that may vary depending on their usage. Thus, Warranty for the batteries is covered by a separate Limited Warranty Agreement that better suit the different nature of the batteries, as a product.
- List of other Excluded Items: Cosmetic damage, shipping damage, or damage caused by accidents or misuse.
- Warranty Process: To file a warranty claim, please contact the manufacturer directly at [manufacturer's contact information]. The manufacturer will then provide you with instructions on how to return the Product for service.

Extended Warranty:
